"JESUS IS NOT GOD"

You couldn't have missed it unless you were hiding behind Mt. Baldy! My wife and I were driving north on Interstate 15 the other day when we saw a giant billboard that read, "JESUS IS NOT GOD." The sign went on to read, "Scripture says... Jesus did not pre-exist in heaven." Well, it's a free country. The Constitution protects the rights of misguided people to waste their advertising dollars on ignorant statements about the Lord. My hope is that Bible-believers know enough Bible to defend their beliefs against clueless claims on highway signs!



Does the Scripture *really* say that Jesus did not pre-exist in heaven? Not in my Bible! When Jesus was praying to the Father in John 17:5 He said, "And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was." John 1:1-2 plainly tells us that Jesus is the Word, and that He was "in the beginning with God." Carefully read Colossians 1:17. Jesus "is before all things, and by him all things consist." Not only was Jesus pre-existent in Heaven, He was pre-existent *before* Heaven! (If you need more Bible proof of the pre-existence of Jesus, study the following: **Jn 8:58; Mic 5:2; Heb 1:2-3; Rev 22:13.**)

John 20:27-28 Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing. 28 And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God.

Philippians 2:5-6 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: 6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

1 Timothy 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

Hebrews 1:8 But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom.

For more Bible proof on the Deity of Jesus (Jesus is God) study the following passages of Scripture: **Lu 8:39; Jn 1:1; Jn 14:9; Act 7:59; Rom 8:9; Rom 9:5; Rom 14:10-12; Heb 1:8; 1 Jn 3:16; Isaiah 9:6; Compare Ex 3:14 with Jn 8:58; Compare Heb 13:12 with Acts 20:28.** There are dozens of passages that prove the Deity of the Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus was referred to as the Lord in Ps. 110:1 and as Jehovah God in Zech 12. Jesus forgave sins. He claimed equality with the Father. Jesus had creative power. Jesus had power over the elements. Jesus accepted the testimony of Thomas to the fact that He was God. The fact of the resurrection proves beyond any doubt the Jesus was not a mere man but God manifested in the flesh. To deny the Deity of Christ is to rob mankind of a living and real Saviour. Jesus is God!
